Electioneering Regulations and Candidate Space Assignments Precinct 1 Polling Location for the November 8, 2016 Election Day



Electioneering Period:

Monday, November 7 at 5:30 p.m. – Friday, November 11 at 7:00 p.m.

Spots assigned by random drawing held 11/04/16. Additional spots may be assigned to other candidates or measures with a place on this General Election ballot. <u>Time</u>: No sooner than 5:30 p.m. Monday, November 7, 2016 and any later than 72-hours after the polls close.

<u>Place</u>: Each candidate will receive one spot, approximately 10-feet by 15-feet as striped and numbered, within the City right-of-way on the west of Joe Stephens Avenue. Electioneering materials must remain within the assigned spaces. Candidates may place canopies or signage of any size or shape within their assigned electioneering space; please note that due to space constraints and safety concerns, no vehicles are permitted in these spaces.

<u>Manner</u>: Canopies and signs must be independently upright; do not stake the grass or affix to the Airport fence. Also, no parking along the curb.

Each political sign or electioneering material and every day such violation continues shall be deemed to constitute a separate offense (misdemeanor/\$500). In addition to any criminal penalty, political signs and other electioneering materials on any public property in violation of this section may be removed and disposed of at the direction of the official in charge of the polling place.
